

Water Filter Cartridges Installation







Installation

- Turn off cold water supply and open nearest faucet to drain pipes before starting installation. Place a tray or towel under the cold water line to catch excess water.
- Remove housing from filter head and set aside.
- Remove o-ring from housing. Lubricate with a water based lubricant and seat securely on housing.
- Place filter into housing. Screw bottom of housing onto the cap and hand-tighten.
 DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN. Make certain cap standpipe slips into cartridge.
- Turn on water supply to allow filter to slowly fill with water, then press the p ressurerelief button on the housing to release trapped air. Open faucet and flush filter with water for 5 minutes. Check for leaks and tighten fittings as needed.

Warning

- It's important to seat the O-ring properly in the groove or water leakage may occur.
- FOR COLD WATER USE ONLY (40-100°F), DO NOT INSTALL ON HOT WATER.
- The filter cartridge has a limited service life. A decrease in water flow indicates that the cartridge should be replaced.
